## *FEDERAL REPORTING*

Report to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security at 1-866-347-2423 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, every day of the year. Individuals across the world can report suspicious criminal activity to the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) Tip Line. The Tip Line is accessible internationally by calling 1-802-872-6199. Highly trained specialists take reports from both the public and law enforcement agencies on more than 400 laws enforced by ICE HSI, including those related to human trafficking.

The State Department's Diplomatic Security Service (DSS) investigates visa and passport fraud. Human trafficking often includes visa fraud. As a result, DSS works with its U.S. and international law enforcement partners to investigate these crimes. ## *INTERNATIONAL REPORTING ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING*

### **ENGLAND**

The National Crime Agency (NCA) recommends that if you suspect modern slavery, report it to the Modern Slavery Helpline on 08000 121 700 or the police on 101.

If you suspect human trafficking, call the police. Call 999 if it's an emergency, or 101 if it's not urgent. If you'd prefer to stay anonymous, call Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111. If you don't want to call the police, you can talk to a charity anonymously.

### **SCOTLAND**

If you suspect there are people who have been trafficked into your community or you have concerns about an adult or child whom you think may be being exploited, please report this to Police Scotland on 101. In an emergency always dial 999. You can also use our online Contact Form. You can contact Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111. Your call will be treated in confidence. You can report via the Modern Slavery helpline on 08000 121 700 or on the Modern Slavery helpline website.

### **IRELAND**

If you consider yourself or somebody else to be a victim of human trafficking, you should report your concerns to the Garda Síochána (Irish police force). In an emergency, you should call 999 or 112.
